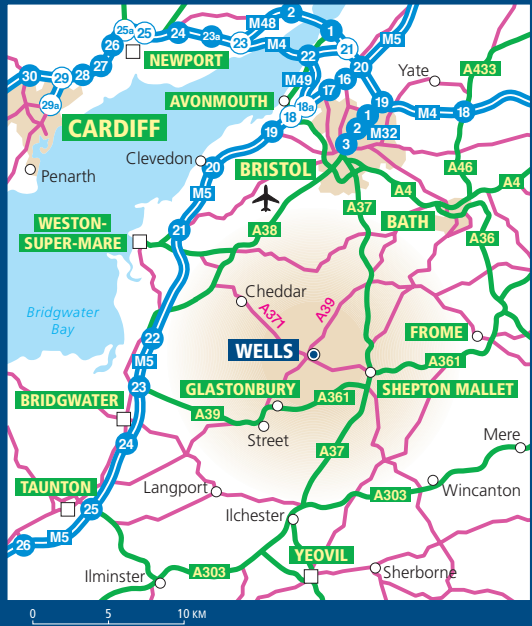


# THE BLUE SCHOOL

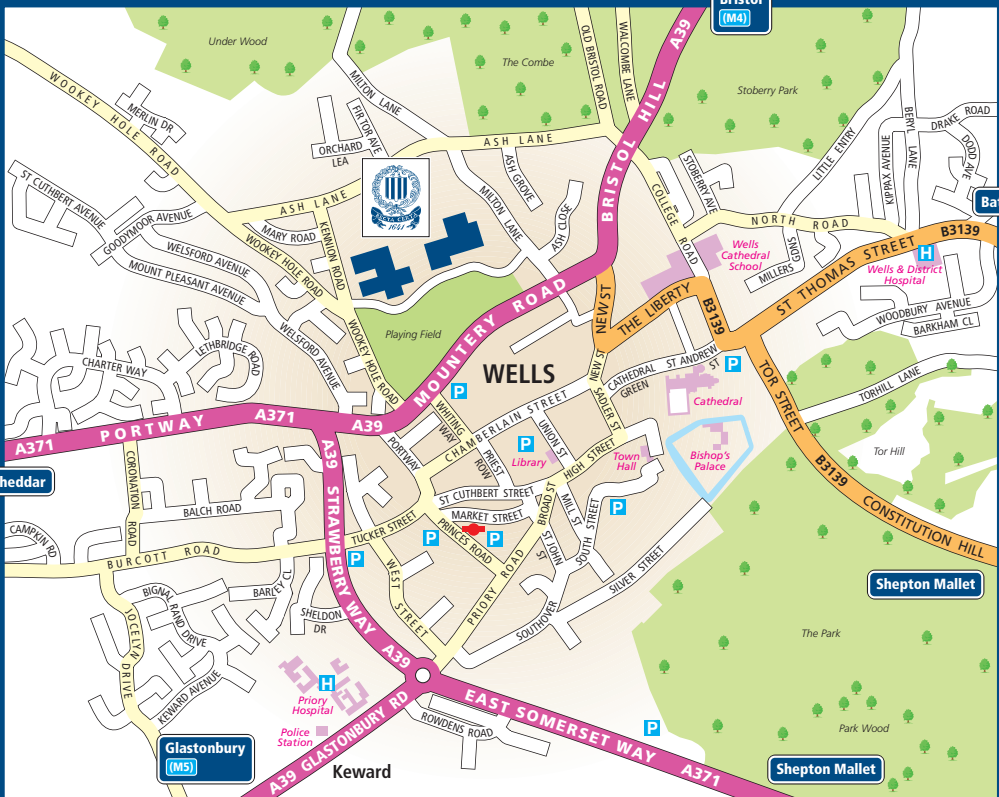
An 11-18 mixed Comprehensive School with approximately 1450 pupils on roll (including over 200 students in the Sixth Form) and more than 200 staff.

The history of the school dates back to 1641 with a charitable foundation, and it had become known as The Blue School by about 1750, after the colour of the free blue uniform. It now has a genuinely comprehensive intake, drawn both from the City of Wells and surrounding villages.

The quality of the environment is a source of pride. The school campus is most attractive, with approximately 30 acres of playing fields and a superb view across the City towards the Cathedral. The School shares the campus and facilities with Wells Blue Sports Centre.
