<b>GENERAL UNIFORM CODE</b>			
Jewellery: Students with pierced ears may wear one small round plain stud or sleeper per ear. No other jewellery is allowed other than when occasional permission is granted to wear items associated with charity campaigns. Parents are asked to arrange such piercing during holiday times so that the wearing of studs will not be required during school time. Badges awarded for achievement and service may be worn.			
Outdoor coats, with the exception of the approved Finland Jacket available through the uniform shop, may be worn to and from school only.			
Hair should be clean, neat and tidy. Students with long or braided hair should be prepared to tie it back for practical activities. As a guide, hair should be of natural appearance and extremes of fashion should be avoided. Hair which is dyed in obviously unnatural colours is not allowed.			
From time to time certain garments or other accessories become fashionable. The school reserves the right to ban these where they are considered unsuitable.			

From September 2009 the new uniform code is compulsory for students in Years 7 - 11.
