YEAR 7 CAMP 2019

We are busy organising our annual Summer Camp for Y7 students. This will run from the morning of Sunday 7th July to the afternoon of Saturday 13th July 2019, with each group spending 2 nights at the camp. This will be the twenty fifth year that we have run a camp and they have proved to be enormously successful and memorable for both students and teachers. It provides an opportunity for students and teachers/form tutors to work together as a team in a different and challenging environment. We feel there are enormous benefits for students sharing in a residential experience and supporting each other, and we will devote a good deal of tutor time to preparation so that each student is aware of exactly what is involved.

The camp will be based at the Forestry Commission Site at BRACELANDS near COLEFORD in the Forest of Dean close to the Gloucestershire/Gwent border. The site, which enjoys extensive views and excellent facilities, gives easy access to many parts of the Wye Valley. Each student's time at camp will be occupied in a full range of educational and recreational activities including forest walks, orienteering exercises, visits to Goodrich Castle, Symonds Yat, the Jubilee Maze and a full day of outdoor pursuits with fully qualified instructors.

We hope that all Y7 students will be able to take part and that parents will make every effort to enable their children to attend, as we truly believe the camp to be an extremely valuable and unique experience. For the remainder of the school week Y7 students will be taking part in Enrichment week activities on site. Further details about these will be announced early next term.

The cost, which is fully inclusive of food, transport, excursions, activities and campsite fees, will be **£100.00**, which will need to be met fully by voluntary contributions. However, the contribution is waived for those students eligible for Pupil Premium (for additional information go to www.theblueschoolwells.co.uk/section.php/368/1/finance).

3. **Payment:**

A minimum deposit of **£40.00** is required by **Friday 8th March** along with the signed permission and medical form. Please see below for a suggested payment plan for the remaining balance. However, you may wish to pay in instalments to suit you but please note that the £105.00 must be paid in full by **Monday 3rd June**.

Deposit - £40.00 – payment due by Friday 8th March
2nd Instalment - £30.00 – payment due by Friday 26th April
3rd Instalment - £30.00 – payment due by Monday 3rd June

Our preferred method of payment, using a credit/debit card over the Internet, is via Tucasi Online Payments. We would urge you to contact the Finance Office on 01749 836262 if you have not yet created your Tucasi account. Please note that the amount of £100.00 shown on Tucasi needs to be altered to the amount you wish to pay and this will then be deducted from your outstanding balance.

Alternatively, please return payment (cheques made payable to The Blue School with your child's name, tutor group and 'Y7 Camp' on the reverse) to the Finance Office at break only, 11.10-11.30am, by the due dates.

4. **Daily Routine:**

Timings may vary slightly for different groups but in general breakfast will be at 8.00am, packed lunch at approximately 1.00pm and dinner at 6.30pm. In the morning students may not leave their tents before 7.00am except in an emergency when they should report to their Form Tutor. The daily programme will run from 9.00am until 5.00pm. All students will have chosen to take part in various activities; archery, canoeing or the ropes course. All these activities are led by very experienced and fully-qualified instructors. There will also be organised evening activities which will normally end by 9.30pm.

5. **Money:**

There will be an opportunity to buy sweets and small souvenirs after some of the activities but there is no necessity for children to have a large amount of pocket money to spend. We suggest a limit of £10.00.

8. **Camping Equipment:**


Tents will be used for sleeping, not as social areas. No one is allowed into any tent other than their own.
