Psychology of a Serial Killer– Westlands Entertainment Venue, Yeovil, Friday 4th October 2019

We are inviting your child to see the evening talk of 'The Psychology of a Serial Killer' at The Westlands Entertainment Venue in Yeovil on Friday 4th October 2019. The talk is linked to the Psychology specification in first year where students study abnormality and to the Forensic Psychology topic in second year.

The talk will explain how to classify serial killers using case examples such as Fred and Rose West, will show facial reconstruction of a skull after body discovery and will answer some common questions about serial killers and victims.

The talk does have an age 18 advisory rating due to the nature of its content however, the venue are happy for students to attend if they are not yet 18.

We will depart by coach from Milton turning circle at 6.00pm and return to school by 10.15-10.30pm. Your child may want to bring some money to be able to buy a programme/refreshments.
