### **Enrichment Week – 8<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> July**

The Blue School are delighted to announce the launch of a brand new Enrichment Week which will run from 8<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> July 2019. The week will give students the chance to try new experiences and develop new skills in what will be an exciting week in the school calendar. The Blue School is committed to supporting your child with all aspects of their personal development. Enrichment Week offers your child an opportunity to participate in a wide range of activities and to work alongside other members of our community. We hope that students who are trying something new for the first time will discover an interest that may blossom into a passion that they choose to pursue in their own time.

Please follow the guidelines below to book your child onto the Enrichment Week.

1. Read the Enrichment Week options booklet with your child, which is available on the school website in the parent/carer section.
2. Select your choices by clicking on the hyperlink at the end of the booklet and completing the Google form.
3. Students must select 5 activities (Maximum 3 off site visits) along with 3 reserve choices (Maximum of 1 off site visit).
4. **Booking will open on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2019**
5. **Booking will close on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2019**

Paper versions of the Enrichment Week options booklet will be available if you are unable to access the document online and your child can collect this from Reception. You will see from the booklet that we have tried to ensure everyone has access to a balanced range of activities throughout the week. We strongly encourage the booking process to be completed as soon as possible and be done collaboratively between you and your child.

Please be aware that once the activity schedule for students has been finalised, changes will not be possible and therefore students should choose carefully in discussion with you as their parents/carers. Expectations regarding attendance remain the same as any school week.

We have worked to minimise cost for each activity. To achieve this please be aware that after the booking and payment has been made no refunds will be given if your child subsequently is unable to attend their activity. Parents/carers of students who are eligible for Pupil Premium (i.e. currently, or in the previous 6 years, in receipt of Free School Meals) will receive a voucher of £50.00 maximum towards the total cost of the week. We have tried to ensure that there are a variety of activities available at no cost to make the week as affordable as possible.

**Booking will close on 25<sup>th</sup> February and from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March payment will be possible via Tucasi online payments, with a deadline of Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2019. It will be possible to spread payments over a period best suited to you. If total payment is not received by the deadline, we will relocate your child from the activities that have not been paid for to a free activity.**

We are looking forward to this week and the activities planned for our school community. Our aim is for it to be an exciting, memorable and rewarding week for your child where they experience new things, overcome challenges and have fun at the same time.
