Locked in a Room/Za Za Bazaar visit- Tuesday 17th December 2019

The Psychology Department has arranged a visit to 'Locked in a Room' Bristol. This is Bristol's largest themed escape room experience where students will have 60 minutes to escape a locked room by solving puzzles, riddles and discovering clues. This will challenge the students' thinking skills, change their mindset to that of thinking in riddles and as completed in small groups will require strong teamwork and leadership skills.

There are two experiences to escape from:

Parallax- students will have to solve riddles/clues to find Professor Pottenger who has been kidnapped by unknown assailants.


Infinity- students will have to solve riddles/clues to help find the laboratory of Dr Scabworthy where there is an infinity device that has begun to melt down threatening life on earth.

During both of these experiences, students will have to immerse themselves in the task at hand - to escape! They will be challenged and will need to stay focused as the 60-minute timer counts down. Students will be randomly assigned to a room. After the escape room has been completed, we will then visit Za Za bazaar for lunch.

The cost of the visit is **£35.00** per student; this includes a discounted entrance to Locked in a Room, lunch at Za Za Bazaar and coach transport to and from the venue. We will be leaving school at **10.30am** and arrive back at school at approx. **4.30pm**.
